Package Overview

Pitra Paksha, also spelt Pitri Paksha, is a 16-lunar day period in the Hindu calendar when Hindus pay homage to their ancestors, especially through food offerings. The period is also known as Pitri Paksha/Pitr-Paksha, Pitri Pokkho, Sorah Shraddha, Kanagat, Jitiya, Mahalaya, Aparaksha and akhadpak. It usually falls during the waning phase of the moon (Krishna Paksha) in the month of

Ashwin (September–October). Performing these rituals is believed to help in resolving family issues, ensuring prosperity, and receiving blessings from departed ancestors.

Day Wise Itinerary



DAY 01

Pitra Paksh Pooja

- Arrive at Haridwar. Check in at hotel, freshen up and Leave for Har-ki-Pauri at and take Ganga Snaan. Gather offerings such as water, sesame seeds, rice, and specific items for the rituals. Conduct special ceremonies and offer food to Brahmins or family members as a symbolic gesture of feeding the ancestors. Offer pindas (rice balls) made with sesame seeds, barley, and other ingredients to honour the deceased.
